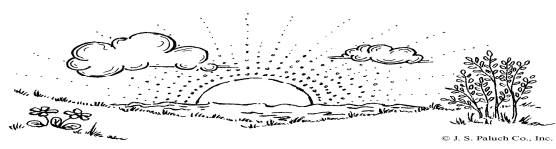

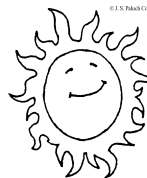

Parish Mission

The Partner Parishes of St. Peter in Brownsville and St. Cecilia in Grindstone announce a parish mission to be held at our churches beginning the weekend of May 15/16. Fr. Angelus Shaughnessy, O.F.M. Cap., will preach at all the weekend Masses (at St. Peter’s 5 p.m. Saturday Vigil; Sunday morning 8 and 11:30 a.m.; at St. Cecilia’s Sunday morning 9:30). On Sunday evening at 7 p.m. at St. Peter’s there will be a Holy Hour with prayer, song, sacred scripture, conference and benediction. Monday evening at 7 p.m. at St. Cecilia’s will be the same schedule; Tuesday evening will be at St. Peter’s. Masses will be celebrated on Monday and Tuesday morning at 9 a.m. at St. Peter’s and the closing Mass will be at 7 p.m. Wednesday evening at St. Cecilia’s. Confessions will be available after Masses; at 3 p.m. at St. Peter’s on Monday and Tuesday; at 3 p.m. on Wednesday at St. Cecilia’s as well as after each of the evening services. The general theme of the Mission is: “Do Whatever He Tells You!” None of the talks will be repeated

TRANSFORMATION

When we clean, repair, or otherwise restore things in our possession, we often say “good as new” or “just like new.” This, according to the book of Revelation, is what happens to anything that is filled with the glory of Christ. When scripture uses the word “new” it doesn’t merely mean “a different one, a replacement” (as our advertisements do), but it carries the sense of something being transformed so fully and completely that it is now almost unrecognizable.

Our world is filled with tears, death, pain, thirst, darkness; but the new world—the new heavens and new earth brought about by Christ’s resurrection—is filled with joy, everlasting life, glory, living water, and light. As Paul noted in his second letter to the church at Corinth, if we are in Christ, then we are a new creation. And disciples who are a new creation, who live in the new heaven and earth brought about by Christ, are also daily practitioners of a new commandment: to love one another with that transforming, re-new-ing love that Christ bestowed on us.
