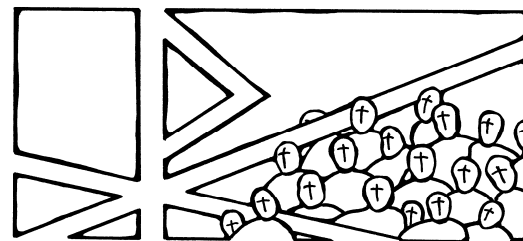

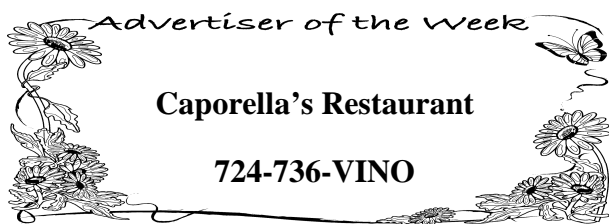
TODAY'S CHALLENGE TOMORROW'S HOPE

I am thrilled to report that Saint John Parish has as our final campaign figure \$629,360. That is 157% of our goal. NOT to make it any kind of competition. (I was blasted in an ANONYMOUS phone message for doing that at one point ... although anything anonymous is by definition to be utterly ignored) - BUT rather to show what an incredible community we have - that figure places us fourth overall in the entire Diocese. All I can say is WOW! and THANK YOU! An especial THANK YOU goes out to our campaign chairwoman, the redoubtable Joanne Torruiso and ALL the men and woman who served on the parish Leadership Team! THANK YOU! THANK YOU! THANK YOU!

I am additional thrilled to report that we have already received our first rebate from the campaign, a cheque in the amount of \$40,000. Those funds will help cover the various projects currently underway. We are also in the process of getting bids to address the restroom facilities in the Parish Centre. We need to have the upstairs restrooms in working order before we can move Religious Formation back to the building, something necessitated by the sheer number of students.

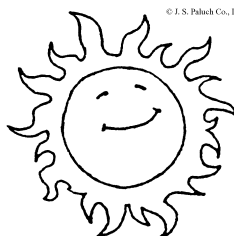
