

PAVING STONES

MEMORIALS AND HONORARIA

We are preparing to begin work on the long awaited landscaping project in front of the Social Centre, including the grotto and gazebo. Ground-breaking will occur after next month's parish festival. Much interest has already been expressed in the memorial paving stones which will cover the walkways winding through the grounds. We have prepared this FAQ sheet to help answer any questions you may have.

- 1) Does someone need to be deceased in order to have their name on a stone? **No! Stones can be purchased for the dead (memorials) or for living (honoraria).**
- 2) Do stones have to be in memory or honour of a person? **No! A stone could be inscribed with the name of any business or organization wishing to play a part in the beautification of the parish grounds.**
- 3) Are there different sizes available to fit different budgets? **Yes! We are offering three options:**
 - 5 3/8" x 8 1/8" for \$100
 - 8 1/8" x 10 7/8" for \$150
 - 10 7/8" x 16 1/2" for \$225 (This last option was added to the original 2 choices at the suggestion of the landscape architect.)
- 4) How much can be inscribed on each stone?
 - 5 3/8" x 8 1/8" - 3 lines 13 characters/spaces per line
 - 8 1/8" x 10 7/8" - 4 lines 16 characters/spaces per line
 - 10 7/8" x 16 1/2" - 5 lines 20 characters/spaces per line
- 5) How do I obtain a stone? **Simple! Fill out the form on the back, indicating the size of the stone you desire and the inscription you would like. Then return it to the office in person, via the post, or by dropping it in the collection basket.* If you have already contacted the office, a form will be sent to you.**
- 6) Can I order more than one? **YES! However, please submit a form for each paving stone. Additional forms can be obtained from the office.**

* Because of accounting restraints we cannot accept orders for stones prior to 1 July unless the cheque is post-dated.
